Hospital beach was where Kitimat's first hospital was, now a public beach. Travel there and find a shell, then take a picture of it.

Located just before you head into town you will find the bear at the top of the stairs. Take a photo with Bob and then be on your way.

### View Point

It's home to one of the most scenic sites in Kitimat. Find the view point that overlooks the Douglas Channel and snap a photo of you with the view in the background.

Find a maple leaf and take a picture of it (but make sure to leave it on the tree).</p>	<p><b>Largest Living Sitka</b></p> <p>The Giant Spruce was previously the largest living Sitka Spruce in BC. Find the tree and snap a picture.</p>	<p><b>People of the Snow</b></p> <p>In Kitimat we are known as the "people of the snow". Find the large snowflake just before town and snap a picture with it.</p>
<p><b>Monkey Around</b></p> <p>Kitimat Public Library holds a copy of the story of "Monkey Beach", which is located just down the Douglas Channel. Find this book and snap a photo with it.</p>	<p><b>Have a Craving?</b></p> <p>Head to the locally owned Constant Cravings and try any of their delicious homemade baked goods. Don't forget the photo.</p>	<p><b>Hudson's Bay</b></p> <p>In 1954 Kitimat had a Hudson's Bay which was Kitimat's first department store. The foundation is still there today. Find it and take some time to read a little bit about it, then snap a picture.</p>
<p><b>Totem Poles</b></p> <p>Each totem pole is carved and painted to tell a story or to commemorate the history, people and events. Find as many totem poles as you can in both Kitimat town site and Kitamaat Village.</p>	<p><b>Waterfalls</b></p> <p>Nothing beats seeing water rushing through rocks and feeling the spray of it falling into the pools below. Kitimat is home to many waterfalls. Find one and take a picture of it.</p>	<p><b>Food Truck Find</b></p> <p>The Kitimat town site and the Kitamaat Village are home to amazing food trucks. Find one and take a photo of you enjoying your meal.</p>
