Board of Variance – 1 position

Board of Variance members meet as needed to hear appeals from property owners who wish to change property siting requirements set by zoning regulations.

Role of the Commission:

- Be able to appreciate community and neighbourhood aesthetics
- Be able to read construction drawings
- Have good knowledge of building procedures and materials

Downtown Design Panel – 1 position

Downtown Design panel members support downtown revitalization by providing feedback to staff via email on an as needed basis on proposed developments in the Downtown Revitalization area.

Advisory Commission for Persons with Disabilities - 5 positions

Members meet monthly to discuss ideas for a barrier-free community to help improve the quality of life for all in Kitimat.

Role of the Commission:

- To advise Council on matters presently under consideration which affect those with a disability.
- To monitor District programs to ensure that the needs of those with a disability are considered.
- To work cooperatively with District departments, Boards, and Commissions whose activities affect those with disabilities and to provide advice and information to them.
- To encourage and facilitate feedback through existing channels from those with disabilities on civic matters affecting them.
- To bring to Council matters identified by the Commission as requiring action by the District.
- To deal with any matters concerning those with disabilities which may be referred to the Committee by council.
