Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – August 15, 2022

- Council postponed the nuisance property hearing for 31 Egret Street to September 6, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.
- Council received a presentation from BC Hydro regarding concerns raised regarding an inspection chamber on Oersted Street and the circumstances when BC Hydro would connect to municipal storm drain system.
- Council received a presentation from BC Transit regarding transit activities in Kitimat.
- Council received a presentation from FireSmart Kitimat on the 2022 FireSmart activities in the community.
- Council authorized support for an application to Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) Northern Healthy Communities Fund Capacity Building Program to implement an intensive three-year workforce attraction campaign.
- Council requested staff report back on a request for a letter of support to exempt newspapers from the extended producer responsibility (EPR) regulation. Staff will report back at a future meeting of Council.
