Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – August 22, 2022

- Council received a presentation from Coast Mountain Children’s Society and provided a grant of \$20,000 to the Coast Mountain Children’s Society to assist with necessary costs associated with providing an increase to the number of childcare spaces available in Kitimat.
- Council received a presentation from the Tamitik Status of Women on the Kitimat Poverty Reduction Strategy.
- Council received a presentation from staff regarding the improvements to the City Centre Courtyard located behind the Kitimat Museum and Archives.
- Council provided direction to staff regarding the Commercial Centre Revitalization Tax Exemption Program Bylaw No. 2018, 2022. Council will consider the bylaw at a future meeting of Council.
- Council provided direction to staff regarding the Energy Emissions and Solid Waste Advisory Committee (EESWAC). Council will consider adoption of the terms of reference at the September 6, 2022, meeting of Council.
- Council received a report with the statement of 2021 Council expenses.
