REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

CON #402 – Roll-Off Bin Hauling Services Kitimat Landfill

The District of Kitimat (the "District") requests Proposals from qualified and experienced Contractors to provide roll-off bin hauling services at the Kitimat Landfill, and between the Kitimat landfill and a couple of solid waste facilities.

To maximize waste diversion, starting in November 2021 the District will be modernizing its residential curbside collection service by collecting garbage, food waste and residential packaging and printed paper (PPP) on behalf of Recycle BC. The new service will collect food waste weekly, with garbage and PPP collected bi-weekly on alternating weeks. The residential collection service is provided on a fixed schedule Tuesday to Friday each week.

The curbside contractor will deliver loads of food waste four days per week on a weekly basis to the Kitimat Landfill where it will be deposited in a roll-off container for transport to the Forceman Ridge Solid Waste Management Facility located at 3112 Highway 37. The contractor will deliver loads of PPP four days per week on a bi-weekly basis to the Kitimat Landfill where it will be deposited in roll-off containers for transport by the Proponent to the Recycle BC consolidation facility anticipated to be located in Terrace/Thornhill (see attached Solid Waste Hauling Map). All roll-off containers must be leak proof with hinged lids.

The District also intends to prohibit the disposal of food waste from commercial and institutional sources and anticipates that this ban will come into effect by June of 2022.

As this is a new service, the District does not have accurate data regarding the quantities of materials that will be collected. However, based on data from comparable local government programs, District consultants estimate the following quantities will require bins and transfer as outlined in Table 1. These quantity estimates include the potential participation of households in Kitimaat Village as well as food waste from commercial and institutional sources which will be subject to a disposal ban by June 2022.

A mandatory pre-proposal meeting will be held at 11:00 am Pacific Time on September 2nd, 2021 at the Kitimat Landfill (No. 93 Highway 37, Kitimat, B.C.).
