March 16, 2020 – District of Kitimat Council will proceed with Council meetings as scheduled. Due to the risk of COVID-19, and that the Council Chambers is a smaller space, the District of Kitimat will attempt to implement the recommended precautionary social distancing during Council meetings.

The public is advised to please refrain from attending meetings if you;

- Have been in close proximity to anyone who has been/is under quarantine, or has tested positive for COVID-19
- Have travelled outside the country in the past 2 weeks, or have been in close proximity to anyone that has been out of the country in the past two weeks
- Have or had a fever, cough, or shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
