MASKS MANDATORY IN MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AGAIN

August 24, 2021 – By order of the Provincial Health Officer, starting on Wednesday, August 25, all visitors to municipal facilities must wear masks while in indoor public spaces. Employees and visitors who are 12 and over who are not wearing masks will be denied entry and/or asked to leave the facility regardless of their vaccination status.

There are exemptions for:

- People with health conditions or with physical, cognitive, or mental impairments who cannot wear one
- People who cannot remove a mask on their own
- Children under the age of 12
- People who need to remove their masks to communicate due to another person's hearing impairment

Masks may be removed temporarily in indoor public places to:

- Identify the individual wearing the mask
- Consume food or beverage at a location designated for this purpose
- Participate in a sport or fitness activity (masks must be worn when not engaged in physical activity)
