The District of Kitimat is seeking a qualified and skilled Recreation Attendant III to support the operation and maintenance of the Tamitik and Kitimat Ice Rinks.

This position is perfect for a team player with working knowledge of ice making, refrigeration and resurfacing operations, including the ability to operate related equipment. Candidates will also have working knowledge of materials, methods and equipment used in janitorial and building maintenance and the ability to perform a variety of building and equipment maintenance duties and routine repairs.
