



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary – August 19, 2019

- Council heard from Micaela Stevenson and Amy McCulley, FireSmart Coordinators about the FireSmart Program and the summer's activities.
- Council heard from Sgt. Eric Black on the policing activities for June and July.
- Council gave three readings to the Northern Capital and Planning Reserve Bylaw 1953, 2019. This bylaw authorizes the establishment of a reserve fund for the purpose of the Northern Capital and planning grant of \$1,566,000 the District of Kitimat received in April for capital and planning purposes.
- Council approved an upgrade of computer servers.
- Council approved amendments to Kitimat's Official Community Plan and Municipal Code to be brought forward to indicate that temporary use permits may authorize short-term commercial land uses in all commercial zones and short-term industrial land use in the C12 Commercial Transition and Residential Dormitory Zone, as well as to allow temporary use permits in all industrial zones. Bylaw consideration and a public hearing (if the bylaw proceeds) will be determined at a later date.
- Council approved \$25,000 seed funding from the Affordable Housing Fund to Tamitik Status of Women to assist in project development for 461 Quatsino Boulevard.
- Public notice was approved for issuance of a Temporary Use Permit application for an RV park on a portion of the Sandhill property (District Lot 6060, west of CN Rail right-of-way.)
- Council heard a Quarterly Financial update from the Director of Finance.
