



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – January 6, 2020

- Council heard from the Kitimat-Terrace Clean Air Coalition on the results from the Passive Air S02 Project.
- Council adopted the Bulk Water and Sewage Disposal Rates, Bylaw No. 1964. This bylaw establishes the fees for bulk water services and sewage disposal services.
- Council gave three readings to Refuse Collection Rates Amendment Bylaw No. 1966, 2020. This bylaw would amend the refuse collection rates for 2020 to \$95.
- Council approved a one-year extension to the current agreement with Tamitik Status of Women for the use of the building at 225 Enterprise.
- Council appointed Councillor Gibson and Councillor Empinado as representatives to the Kitimat Airshed Group.
- Council approved a motion that staff develops a zoning amendment bylaw to allow detached accessory dwelling units in G3-A Cable Car Greenbelt Zone and for properties zoned C4 Local Store in Cable Car Subdivision.
- Council approved a motion that a pilot-program transit fare exemption for students under age 18 in Kitimat be added to the 2020 budget. Staff will explore options for this program for Council approval.
- Council approved the 2020 operating grants to community groups and tentatively approved the 2020 revenues and general operating expenses. The 2020 revenues and general operating expenses will receive final approval in spring 2020 when the five-year financial plan bylaw is adopted.
