



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – January 20, 2020

- Council heard from SwissReal Group on a proposed development application.
- Council was updated by the RCMP on their 2019 crime statistics.
- Council adopted the Service Shut-Off and Turn-On Fees, Bylaw No. 1970. This bylaw establishes new rates for water shut-off or turn-on during summer and winter months.
- Council adopted the Refuse Collection Rates Amendment Bylaw No. 1966, 2020. This bylaw changed the yearly refuse collection rate to \$95.00 per year per dwelling.
- Council gave the first two readings to Accessory Dwelling Units for Cable Car Neighbourhood, Bylaw No. 1963, 2020 and set a Public Hearing date of March 2, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers. This bylaw would allow for accessory residential units on select properties in the Cable Car neighbourhood.
- Council gave first reading to Accessory Dwelling Units for Selected Zones and Properties, Bylaw No. 1969, 2020 and set a Public Hearing date of March 9, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers. This bylaw would allow for accessory residential units on select properties in the Strawberry Meadows neighbourhood.
- Council supported a grant application to do Flood Risk Assessment, Mapping and Mitigation through the Union of British Columbia Municipalities.
