## 2022 GENERAL LOCAL ELECTIONS

**PUBLIC NOTICE IS GIVEN AS FOLLOWS:**

### MAIL BALLOT VOTING

#### REQUESTING A MAIL BALLOT PACKAGE:

Mail ballot voting will be available for those electors of the District of Kitimat who are unable to vote at other voting opportunities. Any person requiring information on mail ballot voting, please contact Kiona Enders, Chief Elections Officer or Tracy Tavares, Deputy Chief Elections Officer (contact information below).

NOTE: It is the responsibility of the voter to ensure they contact the Chief Elections Officer or Deputy Chief Elections Officer in sufficient time to receive a mail ballot package and return the ballots.

To receive a Mail Ballot Package the following information must be provided:

- (1) Full name;
- (2) Residential Address;
- (3) Address of the property in relation to which you are voting (for non-resident property electors);
- (4) Method of delivery of your mail ballot package:
  - Pick up at the District of Kitimat Municipal Office, OR
  - Regular letter mail through Canada Post to residential address, OR
  - Regular letter mail through Canada Post to an alternate address that you provide when requesting the ballot package, and
- (5) If you are not on the list of electors, to ensure you receive the correct registration application form in your package, you must indicate whether you are going to be registering as a resident or non-resident property elector.

The District of Kitimat will send out mail ballot packages commencing on or about September 26, 2022. To be counted, your mail ballot must be received by the Chief Elections Officer no later than 8pm on Saturday October 15, 2022.
