## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – March 28, 2022

- Council directed staff to write a letter to the BC Electoral Boundaries Commission to express Council's views on the province's current electoral district boundaries.
- Council provided direction to submit a response to the BC Oil and Gas Commission regarding the proposed Cedar Link Pipeline and Cedar Link Meter Station.
- Council directed to accept the one-time additional funding of \$733,659 from the ChildCareBC New Spaces Fund for the Day Care at 461 Quatsino Boulevard. This will increase the provincial contribution to the project to approximately \$3.2M.
