Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – November 14, 2022

- Council provided a letter of support to the Kitimat Airshed Group Society for their application to the Northern Development Marketing Grant.
- Mayor Germuth was elected by acclamation as the Director to the Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine and Councillor Marleau was elected by acclamation as the Alternate Director to the Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine.
- Council approved their Committee and Commissions list for 2022-2023.
- Council approved the Acting Mayor schedule for their term in office. In the event that Mayor Germuth is unavailable, a Councillor will assume those duties in his absence according to this schedule.
- Council directed staff to submit a grant application to the Northern Development Initiative Trust for the 2023 Business Façade Improvement funding program. The grant is provided for the purpose of enhancing economic development by encouraging private sector investment in business façade improvements. So far in 2022 the District has approved three applications totalling \$15,000.
- Council directed staff to issue public notice on the Sumgas Creek Habitat Offsetting and Access Agreement with LNG Canada. For more information and details on how to comment, please visit the District of Kitimat website under [Public Notices](#).
- Council directed staff to submit a comment to the Ministry of Mines regarding an application by JHW Construction to operate a quarry and temporary asphalt plant near Forest Avenue. The comment outlined a number of factors the District is asking the Ministry to consider.
