



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – December 02, 2019

- Council heard from the Kitimat Valley Naturalists on concerns of Goose Creek in terms of flood protection if a railyard was to be constructed in that area. The group requested that the District of Kitimat hire a hydrologist to review the impacts of such construction.
- Council gave a third reading to the amended Bylaw 1955, 2019 Restriction of Cannabis/Tobacco Use in Public Places and Parks to include comments from Northern Health and others. This bylaw restricts usage of cannabis and tobacco use in public places and parks.
- Council gave three readings to Council Remuneration Bylaw 1960, 2019. This bylaw increases the annual remuneration for Mayor and Councillors by 2.8%, which is the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for June 2018 to August 2019. Council remuneration is determined annually using the CPI from the previous year.
- Council gave three readings to Commissions Amendment Bylaw No. 1961, 2019. The amendment expands the eligibility for appointment to commissions to persons that live outside, but work in Kitimat.
- Council passed a motion that a letter of support be written for the resolutions brought forward by the City of Victoria in respect to Safer Drug Supply to Save Lives and Observed Inhalation Sites for Overdose Prevention.
