



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – February 3, 2020

- Council heard from Mr. Rod Graham, President and CEO of Horizon North Logistics regarding a modular build project.
- Council gave first and second reading to Crossroads Lot 1 and 3, C11 Highway Commercial Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1971, 2020 and referred the zoning amendment application to the Advisory Planning Commission. This Bylaw amends the off-street parking requirement to 0.93 square metres of parking space for every square metre of gross leasable area in C11 Highway Commercial Zone. This is a reduction from 1.5 metres.
A public hearing is scheduled for 6:50 p.m. on Monday, March 2, 2020.
- Council gave second reading to Accessory Dwelling Units for Selected Zones and Properties Bylaw No. 1969, 2020 and referred the amendment application to the Kitimat Housing Committee and Advisory Planning Commission. This bylaw would allow detached accessory dwelling units on selected properties in Strawberry Meadows.
A public hearing is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. on March 9, 2020.
- Council approved submitting a resolution to the North Central Local Government Association titled “Engaging Northern and Remote Communities on New Programs” for consideration during their annual general meeting in May 2020.
- Council approved a letter of support for the First Nations LNG Alliance regarding the City of Victoria’s Declaration of Solidarity with Wet’suwet’en People resolution.
- Council approved applying for a \$37,500.00 Active Transportation Network Planning Grant through the BC Active Transportation Infrastructure Grants Program. This grant helps communities develop active transportation network plans to support active transportation for all ages and abilities.
- Council discussed the 2020 Budget with direction coming at a future meeting.
