Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – February 18, 2020

- Council heard from Lindsay Taylor, Government Relations, BC Transit regarding BC transit services in Kitimat.
- Council approved an amendment to a Road Use and Access Lease Agreement with LNG Canada allowing the removal of large woody debris from the Minette Bay Worksite between 1 April 2020 and 8 September 2020.
- Council received a referral from the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development for an investigative permit for Sea Breeze Power to continue investigative work for wind turbines in and around Clague Mountain Park. Council approved a motion of no objection to the application after attaching conditions to the application.
- Council approved the adoption of the Solid Waste Management Strategy and Action Plan.
- Council approved Mountainview Parking Lot and Nechako Parking Lot (north side of Professional Building) as preferred locations for Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations pending a final assessment and grant funding.
- Council received a report for the 2020 Youth Community Service and Distinguished Citizen Awards. Nomination forms for youth who have provided notable volunteer service to the community and those who distinguish themselves as citizens within our community will be received until April 30, 2020. Awards are presented by the mayor during the July 1, 2020 Canada Day festivities.
