



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – March 9, 2020

- Council heard from Michelle McGregor, Legal Advocate, as well as representatives from IAG Enterprises on the strata conversion application for 1425 Nalabila Boulevard.
- Council gave third reading and adopted Sign Amendment Bylaw No. 1952, 2020. The bylaw creates and amends sign provisions in designated zones.
- Following the earlier Public Hearing, Council gave third reading and adopted Accessory Dwelling Units for Selected Zones and Properties Bylaw No. 1969, 2020. This bylaw allows accessory dwelling units in select areas of Strawberry Meadows.
- Council gave the first three readings to Building Regulations Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 1972, 2020. This bylaw provides for renewal fees for temporary construction trailers and construction trailer complexes.
- Council received an update from the Director of Leisure Services on leisure services programs and facilities.
- Council approved the purchase of a new floor scrubber for Riverlodge Recreation Centre in the 2020 budget.
- Council allocated a facility rental grant of up to \$3,500 and approved an operating grant of up to \$5,000 to the Kitimat Minerals North Conference Committee. Council approved the addition of funds for further grants to the Kitimat Minerals North Conference Committee in the 2021 municipal operating budget. Kitimat is hosting the 2021 Minerals North Conference May 19-21, 2021.
- Council discussed the upcoming release of the District of Kitimat's Housing Action Plan and Needs Assessment.
