



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – May 19, 2020

- Council heard a presentation from Steve Stannus, Project Manager for Kitimat Terrace Clean Air Coalition (KTCAC).
Council approved a funding request of \$3,000.00 for the KTCAC's 2020 Passive Air Monitoring Program.
- Council approved a change to Commercial Use Patios on Public Land Policy C-27 by relaxing the regulations and reducing the application fee by 50% for 2020.
- Council gave first three readings and adopted Unsightly Premises and Various Nuisances Amendment Bylaw No. 1978, 2020. This bylaw will allow staff to undertake action on some unsightly premises investigations.
- Council approved a submission of no objection, with conditions, of the Crown Land Referral for the proposed work outside of the right-of-way on some of the transmission line towers of the Terrace-Kitimat BC Hydro Transmission Line 2L099. Council's conditions include minimal site disturbance and BC Hydro commit to decommissioning the existing transmission line if a new one is constructed in the future.
- Council approved staff requesting CN to chemically treat the invasive plant species, Japanese Knotweed at sites selected by the District of Kitimat while CN is performing their annual vegetation spraying program.
- Council approved writing a letter to the Honourable David Eby in support of North Vancouver's request to support businesses by making liquor licencing more flexible for business recovery during COVID.
- Council had a discussion regarding a mural art program for building façade improvements.
