



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – June 1, 2020

- Council heard from Chelsea Bemis regarding a playground in the Forest Hill Heights Neighbourhood. Council allocated \$56,000.00 from reserves for future improvements to the playground site in the Forest Hill Heights Neighbourhood.
- Council gave first three readings and adopted Air Cylinder Service Bylaw No. 1979, 2020. This bylaw establishes a service for filling air cylinders by the Kitimat Fire Department at a cost of \$30.00 for SCBA and SCUBA Air Cylinders and \$40.00 for a “K” Air Cylinder.
- Council approved a strata application for 1425 Nalabila Boulevard with conditions aimed to mitigate effects on current tenants.
- Council received a report from Leisure Services Department and authorized a bylaw be brought forward for consideration with a 0% increase in leisure services fees. The bylaw will also amend the fee schedule to include a fee for room rentals, advertising space, and supplemental items.
- Council considered correspondence from Unifor Local 2301 regarding municipal and regional race-based data collection during COVID-19. A further discussion will be scheduled during a future meeting.
