



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – July 13, 2020

- Council heard from LNG Canada with an update on the construction on the LNG Canada Project.
- Council heard from Coastal GasLink regarding private COVID testing by Coastal GasLink.
- Council received a report with details of the reopening of the Sam Lindsay Aquatic Centre.
- Council received for consideration a development variance permit application for 9 Oersted Street. The application is for the construction of a garage and workshop within 0.9 metres of the rear property line and a height of 4.65 metres. Public Notice will be issued and residents within 30 metres of the property will be notified.
- Council approved the continued closure of meetings to the physical presence of the public due to COVID. In order to allow for as much public participation as possible, all Council meetings will be livestreamed on the District of Kitimat website, regular Council meetings will continue to broadcast on City West, and, upon request, details to attend electronically are available. Council agenda packages and meeting minutes continue to be available on the District of Kitimat website.
- Council directed staff to lobby the Provincial Government to create left-hand turn lanes at both Onion Lake Ski Trail access road and Hirsch Creek Park access road.
