



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – September 8, 2020

- Council heard from the Kitimat Heritage Group and Kiwanis Club regarding the Kiwanis clock at City Centre. Council has requested staff report back on options to include a heritage clock in the budget.
- Council adopted Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 1987, 2020. This bylaw provides for property tax exemptions for 2021 – 2025 for certain not-for-profit properties that provide local services.
- Council gave first and second reading to 72 Bittern Street Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1988, 2020 and received the application for a development variance permit at 72 Bittern Street. The development variance application is to increase the maximum access width from 7.5 m to 23.2 m. Public notice will be issued; nearby property owners and tenants will be notified; application will be referred for agency comments; and a public hearing will be scheduled for 7:00 p.m. on Monday 5 October 2020.

- Council received a temporary use permit application from JHW Construction Ltd. to allow quarry operations. The application will be referred for agency comments and public notice will be issued.

- Council approved extending the Kitimat Airport Transportation Subsidy Program until October 31, 2021. The program provides subsidized travel between the Northwest Regional Airport (YXT) and Kitimat for eligible users.
