



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – September 28, 2020

- Council heard from Paul Anderson regarding a potential application for a daycare rezoning to allow for additional employees.
- Council gave three readings to Fire Service Level Reduction Bylaw No. 1989, 2020. This bylaw sets out fire response levels for properties located in the Rio Tinto and LNG Canada industrial areas.
- Council accepted an application for a Development Variance Permit Application at 59 Stickney Street to increase the maximum accessory building height from 3m to 3.84m. Public notice will be issued; nearby property owners and tenants will be notified, and the application will be referred to the Advisory Planning Commission for comments.

- Council approved the variance of the size of a sign at 205 Enterprise Avenue and denied the variance application to allow for a billboard sign. Council has directed staff to review the Kitimat Municipal Code sections regarding third party signs.
- Council received an update on the Community Resiliency Fund Applications received so far. As of September 16, 2020, there were nineteen applications approved totaling \$353,015.19.
- Council received an update on capital spending for 2020.
