



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – October 19, 2020

- Council approved comments for an investigative licence extension for Pacific Traverse Energy. The temporary licence allows Pacific Traverse Energy to conduct investigative work related to their proposed Kitimat LPG Export Project.
- Council accepted for consideration an application for a Temporary Use Permit by IAG Enterprises Ltd. for the operation of a portable mill at PID 029-337-216 for a one-year period with the option to renew for an additional year. Public notice will be issued; nearby property owners and tenants will be notified, and the application will be referred to the Advisory Planning Commission for comments.

- Council tabled an application to the Liquor & Cannabis Regulation Branch by IAG Enterprises – Kitimat River Motel and Suites for a new primary liquor licence until more information could be made available.
- Council approved a resolution to not comment on an amendment application to the Liquor & Cannabis Regulation Branch by Civeo Canada Limited Partnership – Stika Lodge for extended hours of service on Sundays from the current hours of 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. to new hours from 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Council requested staff report back on a request by a resident to allow a Julianna mini pig within the District.
