



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – October 26, 2020

- Staff Sergeant Graham Morgan, Kitimat RCMP provided an update on detachment activities and an overview of the monthly statistics for August and September 2020.
- Council directed staff to provide further information on driver distractions, potential light pollution issues, and cost estimates for a proposed downtown electronic sign.
- Council approved a letter of support to My Mountain Co-op for their grant application for expansion of the Shames Mountain parking lot.
- Council received a report regarding the 2020 Annual Kitimat Business Walk. The District of Kitimat partners with the Chamber of Commerce in this annual walk to canvass local businesses as to the present economic climate that they are operating in as well as to identify efforts the community can undertake to improve the local economy. The business walk is scheduled for November 3, 2020.
- Council received a report regarding the successful grant application for the Kitimat Airpark from the Air Access Grants Program in the amount of \$822,913 for airpark upgrades consisting of asphaltting the runway, taxiway and helipad.
- Council approved a resolution to not comment on an amendment application to the Liquor & Cannabis Regulation Branch by Civeo Canada Limited Partnership – Sitka Lodge (100 Loganberry) for extended hours of service on Saturdays from the current hours of 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. to new hours of 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. At its October 19, 2020 meeting, Council approved a resolution not to comment on their application for extension of the same hours on Sundays.
- Council approved a resolution to not comment on an application by IAG Enterprises Ltd.'s Kitimat River Motel and Suites (650 Kuldo Boulevard) to allow an occupancy load of 150 patrons and hours of operation of 9:00 a.m. to midnight on Sunday through Thursday and 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.
- Council approved a grant request of \$30,000 through the Community Resiliency Fund for a Community Rent Assistance Program and will consider a request for an ongoing annual grant during the 2021 budget deliberations.
