



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – November 23, 2020

- Council heard budget presentations from community groups in Kitimat regarding their requests for the 2021 budget as follows:
 - Tamitik Status of Women's request for \$30,600 be referred to the budget process;
 - Kitimat Understanding the Environment's request for a 2% increase be referred to the budget process with the balance of the increase considered separately during budget discussions;
 - Kitimat Community Development Centre's request for \$51,000 be referred to the budget process;
 - Kitimat Public Library's request for \$619,060 be referred to the budget process;
 - Kitimat Community Services Society's request for \$43,330 for their victim services program be referred to the budget process;
 - Kitimat Health Advocacy Group's request for \$15,000 be approved;
 - Kitimat Museum and Archives' request for a 2% increase be referred to the budget process with the balance of the increase considered separately during budget discussions, and the \$10,000 special projects grant request be referred to the 2021 capital budget;
 - Kitimat Arts For Youth's request for \$12,485 be approved;
 - Kitimat Flying Club's request for a 2% increase be referred to the budget process with the balance of the increase considered separately during budget discussions;
 - Kitimat Senior Citizens Association's request for \$33,600 be referred to the budget process; and
 - Mount Elizabeth Theatre's request for \$150,500 be referred to the budget process.
- Council heard from Skeena Sawmills regarding their Timber Supply Analysis Information Package.
- Council requested staff report back further on options to allow pigs in residential areas in Kitimat including the option of using a temporary use permit process.
- Council received a report on the department projects and workloads.
