



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – November 30, 2020

- Council received a presentation from staff regarding asset management and next steps involved in developing an Asset Management Roadmap.
- Council heard from a concerned resident on Baker Street regarding a dog incident.
- Council had a discussion regarding Committee of the Whole meetings.
- Council approved bringing forward a bylaw for consideration to increase refuse pick up fees from \$120 per dwelling in 2021 and to \$146 per dwelling in 2022 with a 10% reduction to those who qualify for the Provincial Home Owners Grant for Seniors and Disabled.
- Council referred an increase to the 2021 water rates to the 2021 budget discussions.
- Council approved the new downtown electronic sign to the location on the north side of Haisla Boulevard between Tsimshian Boulevard and Lahakas Boulevard.
- Council adopted Haisla Bridge Park Closing and Exchange Bylaw No. 1990, 2020. This bylaw is to close, exchange and dispose of a portion of Kitimat River parkland to facilitate the rebuilding of the Haisla Bridge closing. Ultimately, through this reconfiguration, the parkland in the area will increase by approximately 4.4 hectares.

- Council amended the Housing Action Plan and Needs Assessment Work Plan to incorporate input from the Housing Committee.
