Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – January 11, 2021

- Council received a presentation from the Kitimat Terrace Clean Air Coalition providing an update on the 2020 SO² monitoring program.
- Council received a report regarding the Shames Mountain and Onion Lake ski bus and suspended bussing services for the 2020/2021 ski season due to COVID. Council had a further discussion regarding potential changes to how the ski bus services may operate in the coming seasons.
- Council received a report and endorsed the engagement plan for the development of FireSmart Principles for the community.
- Council directed staff to prepare a bylaw to update sections of the Kitimat Municipal Code with respect to the Advisory Planning Commission.
- Council approved the amended 2020-2021 Annual Operating Agreement with BC Transit for bussing in the community.
- Council approved the renaming of the “Economic Development” department to the “Economic Development and Communications” department, to better reflect the functions of that department.
