



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – January 18, 2021

- Council adopted Refuse Collection Rates Amendment Bylaw No. 1992, 2021. The bylaw will increase refuse collection rates from \$95 to \$120 per year in 2021 and \$146 per year starting in 2022. There will be a 10% reduction for those who qualify for the Provincial Home Owners Grant for Seniors and Disabled.
- Council received a report regarding summer student top up funding program.
- Council received a report regarding animal control regulations. Council directed staff to advocate for changes to legislation on dangerous dogs through NCLGA, UBCM and appropriate Provincial Ministries and to draft a bylaw to increase licence fees for Dangerous and intact dogs, as well as create escalating impoundment fees for Dangerous dogs.
- Council directed staff to schedule monthly strategic planning meetings for February through June with the meetings for March, April and June to be scheduled from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Council further directed staff to survey each member of Council to prioritize the order of the strategic planning meeting topics presented.
