Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – February 1, 2021

- Council received a report from staff that the Lieutenant Government in Council approved a Municipal Regional District Tax for Kitimat. Effective May 1, 2021, a two percent tax will be collected on the purchase of accommodation. These monies collected will be managed by a Tourism Advisory Committee to support tourism in Kitimat.
- Council received an update on the strategic planning meetings to be scheduled during February to June.
- Council received a report regarding resolutions to the North Central Local Government Association (NCLGA) Annual General Meeting. The deadline for the District of Kitimat to submit a resolution for consideration during the NCLGA Annual General Meeting is February 26, 2021.
- Council approved a development permit application for Riverbrook Estates (167 Konigus Street) with conditions.
- Council endorsed the Helping Cities Lead Campaign and directed staff to submit a letter to provincial Ministers in support. Helping Cities Lead Campaign is a campaign to accelerate building decarbonization through the collaboration between the Province of British Columbia and local governments.
- Council directed staff to report back on any concerns of the Kitimat-Terrace Regional Airport with respect to the recent changes by Nav Canada to air traffic control services in other regional airports.
