



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – March 8, 2021

- Council tabled a Development Permit Application at 461 Quatsino Boulevard and directed staff to proceed with a Development Variance Permit Application at 461 Quatsino Boulevard regarding a variance of the location of the secondary daycare use relative to principal residential use. The Development Permit and Development Variance Permit will be brought back for Council consideration at a future meeting of Council.
- Council directed staff to prepare a Bylaw to reflect the upcoming changes to the garbage and yard waste collection services as proposed in the Solid Waste Management Strategy and Action Plan.
- Council received a branding and communications update for the Solid Waste Management Strategy and Action Plan.
- Council received a development variance permit application for 20 Swallow Street. The application proposes a variance of the front yard setback from 4.5 metres to 3.96 metres. The application will be referred to the Advisory Planning Commission, public notice will be issued, and all properties on Swallow Street will receive notice of the application.

- Council received a report from the Leisure Services Advisory Committee considering the 2020/2021 fee schedule update. Council approved no fee increase and directed the Leisure Service Advisory Commission to review again in May/June and recommend any fee adjustments for September.
- Council authorized executing a licence with the Provincial Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy allowing access to a District owned lot located at 1000 Eurocan Way to install and monitor a ground monitoring well on that lot.
