



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – March 15, 2021

- Following the Public Hearing on FireSmart OCP Amendment Bylaw No. 1968, 2020, Council gave second and third readings and adopted Bylaw No. 1968, 2020.
- Council received a presentation from Greater Metro Hockey League (GMHL) West Junior A Hockey and directed staff to work with the GMHL executive regarding the proposed establishment of a hockey team in Kitimat.
- Council gave the first three readings to Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Bylaw No. 1994, 2021. The Bylaw supports the Phase 1 changes of the Solid Waste Management Strategy and Action Plan to provide a separate collection service for yard waste and to ban industrial waste and industrial camp waste from the Kitimat landfill site. Bylaw No. 1994, 2021 will be considered for adoption at the April 6, 2021 Regular Meeting of Council.
- Council received a report from representatives from McElhanney regarding the Kitimat River flood mapping study.
- Council approved comment of no objection to approval of project on a referral from the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development for an application for a Telus telecommunications Line for the Coastal Gas Link Meter Station.
- Council received for consideration a Crossing Agreement and Consent to Cross/Encroach in relation to certain portions of District highways with LNG Canada. Public notice of the agreement will be issued. Council will consider approval of the contract a future meeting of Council.
- Council received a letter from the Kitimat Economic Development Association (KEDA). Council will consider the letter when the Kitimat Rod and Gun Association and Environmental Law Centre document “Reforming Kitimat’s Local Laws During an Industrial Boom” and the 8 February 2021 request of the Kitimat Valley Naturalists, Douglas Channel Watch and the Kitimat Rod and Gun Association, to establish a Protected Wetland in the Goose Creek area, are discussed further.
