



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – April 26, 2021

- Council, as members of the Court of Revision, affirmed the 2021 Flat Rate Tax Roll.
- Following a presentation by the Mount Elizabeth Cycling Association (MECA), Council authorized a grant of up to \$19,000 for the development of a master plan and authorized staff to assist with the development of a long-term operating structure for MECA.
- Council directed staff to draft changes to the Kitimat Municipal Code amending the maximum accessory building height for residential properties. Council will consider a bylaw proposing the amendments at a future meeting.
- Council approved the application by the District for a grant from the 2021 Union of British Columbia Municipalities Local Government Development Approvals Program.
- Council approved the upper mall parking lot as the location for a Level 3 Fast Charging Station by BC Hydro and requested staff work with BC Hydro to determine the final location in the upper mall parking lot.
- Council approved the extension of the Student Fare Transit Pilot Program to August 31, 2023. The extension allows for students 18 years of age and younger to continue to use transit services free of charge.
- Council requested staff adjust the Leisure Access Program to a 75% subsidy on drop-ins for persons facing financial barriers.
- Council received a report on the provincial travel restrictions campground bookings.
- Council adopted Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Amendment Bylaw No. 1997, 2021 amending the size of branches collected in the Yard Waste Collection Service to 12mm (1/2 inch) to be compatible with composting.
- Council approved a mutual aid agreement between the District of Kitimat, City of Terrace, and Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine's Thornhill Fire Protection. This agreement allows the sharing of fire resources between communities during a significant event.
