Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – May 17, 2021

- Council received a presentation from Chief Councillor Crystal Smith of the Haisla Nation and Jon Turner regarding the Cedar LNG project.
- Council received a development variance permit application for 18 Moore Street to vary the accessory building height. The application will be referred to the Advisory Planning Commission and public notice will be issued.

The Public Notice, including details on how to comment, will be posted at www.kitimat.ca/pn.

- Council approved a development variance permit application for 121 Liard Street to increase the accessory building height from 3 metres to 3.53 metres.
- Council approved the renewal of the District of Kitimat membership with the Trans Canada Yellowhead Highway Association for 2021.
- Council approved an application to the Union of British Columbia Municipalities 2021 Active Transportation Planning grant for \$20,000.
- Council approved the extension of ice availability at Kitimat Ice Rink until May 31, 2021.
- Council requested a letter be forwarded to the Minister of Municipal Affairs to reiterate the District's NCLGA and UBCM resolutions regarding climate action programs and considerations that should be made to rural and northern communities.
