Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – August 3, 2021

- Council received a presentation from Fire Smart Kitimat on the Fire Smart Program in 2021.
- Following a presentation from Coast Mountain Children Society, Council authorized a letter of support be prepared for their application to the Provincial Government for the \$10/day daycare program.
- Council adopted Ride Share Services Bylaw No. 1965, 2021. Bylaw No. 1965 will regulate ride share services within the District of Kitimat.
- Council approved a resolution not to comment on an amendment application to the Liquor & Cannabis Regulation Branch at Sodexo Canada Ltd. Partnership's Cedar Valley Lodge to allow extended hours of service from Monday to Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Council directed staff to raise an orange flag for the month of September, 2021 in recognition of National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.
- Council approved a resolution encouraging Unifor 2301 and Rio Tinto B.C. Works to meet and work together to come to an amicable agreement that benefits all parties and the larger community and to make a joint statement with other affected elected bodies and officials.
