Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – October 25, 2021

- Following a presentation from the Mt. Elizabeth Cycling Association, Council referred the preparation of a partnership agreement to staff. Council referred the funding request of \$250,000 annually for three years and \$30,000 for annual maintenance to upcoming budget deliberations. The potential partnership agreement would include land use, alternate uses of trails, trail standards, liability, insurance, maintenance, event organization, garbage collection, trail signage and reporting.
- Council received an update on Phase 1 of the development of a Strawberry Meadows Neighbourhood Plan. The intent of the plan is to create clear and concise plans and policies to guide growth and development in the Strawberry Meadows area.
