



Notes from Council

- Members of the Haisla Nation Council attended the Council meeting to discuss concerns regarding the proposal for Reforming Kitimat's Local Laws and Green Bylaws report, and reconciliation between the District of Kitimat and the Haisla Nation.
- Council received an update from BC transit regarding transit services in Kitimat.

BC Transit will be implementing reduced services on the routes 1A, 1B, 2 and 3 on Fridays and Sundays effective December 3, 2021. The expansion of services scheduled for January 2, 2022, will be delayed to March 7, 2022, due to labour shortages. - Council received delegations from the Kitimat Economic Development Association, Clair Rattée, The North Matters, and Corinne Scott regarding the Reforming Kitimat's Local Laws and Green Bylaws report. Members of the public also provided public input on the report.
- Council directed staff to schedule a strategic planning session to discuss a series of questions proposed by Councillor Gibson related to the Reforming Kitimat's Local Laws and Green Bylaws report. The session will be scheduled in spring of 2022.
- Council received a report on Automated Vote Counting. A bylaw will be brought forward to a future meeting of Council to consider the use of Automated Vote Counting for election and other voting opportunities in Kitimat.
