



Notes from Council

- Following a presentation of the 2020-2030 Strategic Plan from the Kitimat Museum and Archives, Council directed staff to include the request for \$6300 for a new building feasibility study in the 2022 budget deliberations and that a link to the Kitimat Museum and Archives landing page be included on the District of Kitimat website.
- District of Kitimat Council Remuneration Amendment Bylaw No. 2008, 2021 was adopted and will come into effect on January 1, 2022. The bylaw increases the Mayor's remuneration by \$1,632.62 per year and the Councillor's remuneration by \$905.90 per year. This reflects the increase to the Consumer Price Index.
- Mobile Food Vendor Bylaw No. 2007, 2021, was given third reading. This bylaw outlines the licensing and operations requirements for mobile food vendors operating within the District of Kitimat. The Bylaw will be presented to Council for consideration of adoption at its December 20, 2021 Regular Meeting.
- Accessory Building and Accessory Structures Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 2006, 2021, received second reading as amended. The Bylaw was referred to the Advisory Planning Commission and a Public Hearing was scheduled for January 17, 2022. The Public Notice, including details on how to comment, will be posted at www.kitimat.ca/pn.
- Council received a presentation from Urban Systems regarding the results of the Nechako Centre Concept Plan survey. A draft concept plan will be developed and provided to Council for review in the spring of 2022.
- Council supported LNG Canada's application for use of an Air Curtain Incinerator and provided additional comments encouraging industry to pursue reasonable alternatives to burning clean wood waste including making it available to the public. The Kitimat Fire and Ambulance Service will monitor the usage and retains the authority to restrict the use of the air curtain incinerator if conditions are not conducive for burning.
- Council directed staff to provide a letter to the Provincial Health Officer requesting reconsideration to the recent COVID-19 restrictions placed on Kitimat.
