



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – December 13, 2021

- Council approved the \$6,700 funding request from the Kitimat Museum and Archives for a shared facility feasibility study.
- Council received a report regarding the ski bus to Shames Mountain (My Mountain Co-op) and the Onion Lake Ski Trails (Snow Valley Nordic Ski Club) and approved a motion not to operate the ski bus for the 2021/2022 season. In lieu, Council did approve operational grants to My Mountain Coop and Snow Valley Nordic Ski Club and the amounts of the grants will be determined through budget discussions.
- Council extended the relaxation of Policy C27 – Commercial Use Patios on Public Land for 2022. This will assist businesses in creating outdoor patio space on public land including the waiving of fees, and reducing the design and conditions associated with the application. The policy and information on the application process is available on our website under Business Incentive Programs.
- Council received for information the report and presentations on the 2022 operational budgets for the District.
