Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – December 20, 2021

- Council received a presentation from the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development on activities in our area in 2021.
- Council received an update from the Kitimat RCMP Detachment of the monthly policing reports for October and November, 2021.
- Council gave first three readings to Automated Vote Count System Authorization and Procedure Bylaw No. 2009, 2021. This bylaw allows for the use of an automated vote counting system for voting opportunities. The bylaw will be brought back to Council to consider adoption at the January 4, 2022 meeting.
- Council adopted Mobile Food Vendor Bylaw No. 2007, 2021. The bylaw outlines the licensing and operations requirements for mobile food vendors operating within the District of Kitimat and will come into effect on January 1, 2022.
- Council waived the building permit fees for the Tamitik Status of Women Housing project at 461 Quatsino Boulevard.
