



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – September 7, 2021

- Following a presentation by Brandi Malo regarding a request for a dog park up the hill in Kitimat, Council referred the request to the Leisure Services Advisory Commission and directed staff to bring back the request for Council consideration during the 2022 budget discussions.
- Council gave the first three readings to Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Bylaw No. 2004, 2021. This bylaw introduces the new collection services for recyclable materials and food waste and amends the collection service for garbage and yard waste. Bylaw No. 2004, 2021 will be considered by Council for adoption at a future meeting.

Further information regarding the new collection services and changes to garbage and yard waste collection is coming soon.

- Council directed staff to prepare a bylaw to amend accessory building provisions in the Kitimat Municipal Code to increase maximum accessory building height to 4.9 metres and increase minimum side and rear yard setback to 1.2 metres provided that the accessory building height does not exceed the height of the primary building on the lot.

Council will consider this bylaw at a future meeting.

- Council directed staff to issue public notice of the District's intention to execute a revised Minette Bay Upland Owner's consent agreement to allow a licence of occupation for LNG Canada with the Ministry of Forests, Lands, and Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development. This licence of occupation would be for a term of 15 years (a two-year extension to the current licence of occupation) and allow LNG Canada to access over District of Kitimat land, DL 471 at Minette Bay, for the purpose of LNG monitoring of salt marshes.

- Council approved a resolution not to comment on an application to the Liquor & Cannabis Regulation Branch by Two Peaks Brewing Ltd. for a new primary liquor licence to allow an occupancy load of 100 patrons.
- Council received for information the quarterly financial report to June 30, 2021.
- Council approved an increase to the budget for a sewer relining project by \$62,875 to \$212,875. This will allow for relining of 500 metres of storm and sanitary sewer pipes on Bayer, Mallard and sections of Nechako Centre.
- Council directed staff to issue a declaration for Waste Reduction Week in Canada which is recognized from October 18-24, 2021.
