



Notes from Council

- Council rescinded third reading of Automated Vote Count System Authorization and Procedure Bylaw No. 2009, 2021 and directed staff to report back on options to include a process for a manual count in the election vote-tabulating. Bylaw No. 2009 will be brought back for Council consideration at a future meeting.
- Council gave three readings to 2022 Revenue Anticipation Borrowing Bylaw No. 2010, 2022. This bylaw allows the District to borrow funds using the 2022 taxes as collateral. Bylaw No. 2010 will be brought back for Council consideration of adoption at a future meeting.
- Council received a report on the recent Annual Kitimat Business Walk. More information can be found on the District website [here](#).
- Council directed staff to report back on options to implement a parental leave policy for members of Council. The policy will be brought back for Council consideration at a future meeting.
- Council continued discussions on the 2022 budget including:
 - directing staff to draft the 2022 budget with a 4% tax increase;
 - directing staff to tentatively fund a grant of \$30,778 to Delta King Place for upgrades to the fire monitoring system at Kiwanis Village from the Affordable Housing Fund;
 - directing staff to tentatively fund a grant of \$35,446 to the Kitimat Community Services Society community rental subsidy program from the Affordable Housing Fund;
 - directing staff to provide further details on the grant requests from Kitimat Understanding the Environment, Kitimat Community Development Centre, Mount Elizabeth Cycling Association and the Kitimat Public Art Alliance, including the effects of any reductions to the amount requested;
 - directing staff to report back on options to repurpose items from the Reserve list; and
 - directing staff to provide additional information on the Council Travel Fund.
