Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – January 31, 2022

- Council received a delegation from Hirsch Creek Golf and Winter Club regarding their financial statements.
- Council provided direction on various items on the Status Report of Regular Council Assignments.
- Council continued discussions on the 2022 budget including:
 - directing staff to draft the 2022 budget with a 3.75% tax increase
 - providing tentative approval to revenues and general operating expenses for 2022
 - consideration of an increase in water rates that will be deferred until after the Water Conservation Plan is presented to Council
 - providing early approval of the following 2022 Projects:
