Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – February 14, 2022

- Council received an update from the Kitimat RCMP Detachment on the Monthly Policing Reports for December 2021 and January 2022.

Council received a presentation from Urban Systems and a report on the Nechako Repositioning Market Report for the Nechako Centre Concept Plan. Next steps will include a presentation to Council of the draft Nechako Centre Concept Plan and additional community engagement which is planned for spring 2022.

- Council received a report on the results of the public consultation process for the Strawberry Meadows Bike Park.
- Council received a presentation and report on the draft Kitimat Water Conservation Plan. Following discussions with Council, Staff will bring back the Kitimat Water Conservation Plan to a future meeting for Council to consider adoption of the Plan.
- Council received a report regarding options for the conduct of elections in Kitimat and provided direction to staff to bring back a report on options for Special Voting opportunities later this spring and to bring back a bylaw to allow for a run-off election if tie vote results between candidates following a judicial recount.

The General Local Election will be held Saturday, October 15, 2022.
