## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – February 28, 2022

- Council received a presentation from Carey McIver, Carey McIver and Associates updating Council on the Solid Waste Management Strategy and Action Plan.

- In early 2021, the District conducted a household survey selecting 707 households at random. The purpose of the survey was to determine: population (both permanent and shadow residents), local employment earnings, household incomes, rent and mortgage costs, and vacancy rates.  
Council received a report from staff along with the District of Kitimat: Household Survey report. This report is available on the District's website [www.kitimat.ca](http://www.kitimat.ca).
- Council adopted the Housing Agreement (Crossroads Residential Dormitory) Bylaw No. 2011, 2021. This bylaw provides an agreement for the residential dormitory development at Crossroads.
- Council directed staff to report back with additional comments in a submission to the BC Oil and Gas Commission regarding the proposed Cedar Link Pipeline and Cedar Link Meter Station. The report will be presented to Council for consideration at a future meeting.
- Council approved submission of two resolutions for consideration at the 2022 North Central Local Government Association, Cultural Awareness Training for All Local Governments, and Registration of Internationally Educated Nurses. If approved by the NCLGA, the resolutions will be debated during the 2022 NCLGA annual general meeting.
