Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – March 21, 2022

- Council gave first two readings to Downtown Revitalization Area Development Permit Area Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 2013, 2022. The Bylaw updates the Official Community Plan to reflect Kitimat's Downtown Design Guidelines.

The Bylaw will be referred to the Advisory Planning Commission, and comment requested from the Haisla Nation, Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine and the Coast Mountains School District.

A public hearing is scheduled for Monday, May 2, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. For more information on the public hearing including the notice documents, you can visit the District website at: www.kitimat.ca/pn.
- Council gave first three readings to Water Rates Amendment Bylaw No. 2012, 2022. The bylaw increases residential, commercial and institutional water rates with the increase taking effect as of May 1, 2022. The bylaw will be brought back to Council to consider adoption at the April 4, 2022 meeting of Council.
- Council received an update on the Strawberry Meadows Neighbourhood Plan. Phase 2 will continue with an in-person open house supplemented with virtual participation later this spring.
- Council provided direction for comments to the BC Oil and Gas Commission regarding the proposed Cedar Link Pipeline and Cedar Link Meter Station. This item will be considered further at the March 28, 2022 meeting.
- Council approved updates to Summer Student Policy S-11 and Respectful Workplace Policy H-06.
- Council appointed the Chief Election and Deputy Chief Election Officers for the 2022 General Local Election. The 2022 General Local Election will be held on Saturday, October 15, 2022.
- Council received a report regarding the Community Recognition of Excellence Program. Nominations in the categories of Youth Community Service and Distinguished Citizen will be received until April 29, 2022, with awards presented during the 2022 Canada Day celebrations.
- Council directed staff to make a donation to the Ukraine Humanitarian Crisis in the amount of \$1,000.
