



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – April 4, 2022

- Council adopted Water Rates Amendment Bylaw No. 2012, 2022. The bylaw provides for an increase to the annual water rates for residential, commercial and institutional users. The increase for residential users is \$1.67 per month and the Bylaw will take effect on May 1, 2022.
- Council approved for consideration a Development Variance Permit Application for 35 Dunn Street. The application is to vary the maximum height of an accessory building from 4.9 meters (16 feet) to 6.1 metres (20 feet). The application was referred to the Advisory Planning Commission for comment and public notice will be issued advising of the application.

- Council approved for consideration a Temporary Use Permit Application for the installation and operation of a portable concrete production plant at 2150 Forest Avenue. The application was referred to the Advisory Planning Commission for comment, and public notice will be issued with a mailout to all properties on Forest Avenue.
