Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – April 19, 2022

- The Public Hearing for Downtown Revitalization Area Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 2013, 2022 was cancelled. At a future meeting Council will set a date for the Public Hearing on Bylaw No. 2013 and issue public notice.

The Bylaw proposes to update the Official Community Plan to reflect Kitimat's Downtown Design Guidelines.

- Council directed staff not to comment on Rio Tinto BC Works' application to temporarily amend Permit No. 100138, P2-0001 Multimedia Waste Discharge Permit for the 2022 Smelter restart.
- Council authorized staff to recommend to the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy to include the designation of an air quality monitoring station in the Service Centre.
- Council received the volunteer commission posting for information. There are several volunteer opportunities on the District's Boards and Commissions. For more information on the opportunities including how to apply, visit the District of Kitimat [website](#).
- Council directed staff to contact BC Hydro encouraging the consideration of connection of the Electrical Inspection Chambers to the District storm system to reduce water pooling.
- Council directed staff to write a letter of support for the City of Fort St. John's request to the Province to recognize the child care challenges for shift workers and consider reviewing regulations to allow extended child care hours at daycares.
