Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – April 25, 2022

- Council received a presentation from Kitimat LNG regarding the decommission plan for the Kitimat LNG project's ancillary properties.

Council passed a resolution that the District would be interested in discussing options to maintain the North Cove Trail as well as construct and maintain amenities for the site. Amenities may include refuse containers, signage, picnic tables, and/or a gazebo or similar structure.

- Council directed staff to reallocate \$30,000 from the 2022 budget to initiatives from the Community Energy and Emissions Plan or Active Transportation Plan.

Council further directed staff to bring back for consideration the bylaws for the five-year financial plan and policies and objectives. The bylaws will be brought back for Council consideration at the May 2, 2022 Regular Meeting of Council.
