



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – May 2, 2022

- Council held the Residential Flat Tax Court of Revision and authorized the Flat Tax Roll for 2022.
- Council received a delegation from Cpl. Bobby Bambury who provided an update on recent police activities regarding enforcement of drug related offences. Council received an update from S/Sgt Graham Morgan on the Kitimat RCMP Detachment monthly policing reports for February and March 2022.
- Council gave first three readings to:
  - Financial Plan Bylaw No. 2014, 2022. Bylaw 2014 sets out the five-year financial plan for the District of Kitimat.
  - Tax Rates Bylaw No. 2015, 2022. Bylaw 2015 sets out the tax rates by property classification for 2022.
  - Residential Flat Tax Rate Amendment Bylaw No. 2016, 2022. Bylaw No. 2016 sets out the flat tax rate for 2022.

Bylaws 2014, 2015 and 2016 will be presented for Council to consider adoption at the May 9, 2022 Special Meeting of Council.

- Council directed staff to issue a letter of support to the Hirsch Creek Golf and Winter Club for their grant application to the NDIT's Recreation Infrastructure Program.
- Council approved an application to the UBCM's Asset Management Planning Program. If successful, the grant would support the District's asset management planning activities.
- Council received for consideration a Development Permit request for a proposed multi-family residential development at a lot abutting Nalabila Boulevard and Wakita Avenue. The application will be referred to the Advisory Planning Commission.

Council will consider the Development Permit application at a future meeting of Council.
